




REACH COMPLIANCE

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations for companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles.

- Under the structure of the REACH Regulation, REGNER® is a manufacturer and supplier of “articles” to our EU customers. We do not manufacture or supply “substances” or “preparations” and our articles do not involve the “intentional release of substances”. Accordingly, we foresee no registration or pre-registration requirement for the products we supply to you.
- REGNER® believes that even though REACH is an EU regulation, the REGNER® ENGINEERING S.L.U. products are affected in all geographical regions. Therefore, REGNER® acknowledges this regulation for all their products, regardless of where our customers are.
- REGNER® is constantly monitoring the substances of very high concern (SVHCs), as defined by REACH, in our products. This will be an on-going process since the complete list of SVHCs will be released in stages.

- REGNER® products do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) above the threshold value declared as per ECHA up to April 10, 2018 with 181 SVHC to the best of our knowledge.
